

**ERRATUM:****Nutritional Status and Food Consumption of Preschool-age Children:
An Observational Cross-Sectional Study Carried Out in Schools
Covered by the Brazilian School Feeding Program**

Following publication of the article by Soares and Del Ciampo in the International Journal of Nutrology, volume 17, issue 3, 2024, DOI 10.54448/ijn24312, the journal identified an error in the reporting of informed consent and child assent. The original article stated in its final declarations that informed consent was not applicable, although the Methods reported authorization by the children's guardians and the article identified the relevant ethics approval. The authors and the Editor confirmed that the study was approved by the Research Ethics Committee of Ribeirão Preto Medical School, University of São Paulo (CAAE 53673421.0.0000.5440; Opinion No. 5.229.786), that written informed consent was obtained from the parents or legal guardians of the participating children, and that age-appropriate assent was obtained from the children before participation. The Abstract, the Materials and Methods section, and the final Ethical Approval and Informed Consent declarations have been corrected accordingly. The static 'Check for updates' image, which was not connected to an operational Crossmark record, was also removed from the revised PDF. These corrections clarify the ethical documentation and do not affect the data, results, interpretations, or conclusions of the article. The original version, published on August 28, 2024, and the corrected version, published on September 16, 2026, remain publicly available on the article page.
